



Helping Students Access Their Scores

Your PSAT Score Report
Scores to Focus On:

- 1 Your TOTAL Score
- 2 Your READING & WRITING Score
- 3 Your MATH Score

Example:



- Students must create a College Board account. After students log in to their College Board account, they should click PSAT, then Add Scores. In the Matching Tool, it is essential that the information in their account matches what they entered on their answer sheet. For example, if they entered “Elizabeth” on their answer sheet and “Beth” in their account, their scores will not load. If they need to change their name, they must call Customer Service at 866-433-7728. All other changes can be made right in their account.
- If that still doesn’t populate the scores, the student will be prompted to indicate which test they’re missing and enter their unique access code to assist the match. To get this code, they will need to see their counselor.
