

HOPE SCHOLARSHIP RIGOR REQUIREMENTS

STUDENTS MUST RECEIVE CREDIT IN THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF COURSES:

- 1) Advanced math: Advanced Algebra and Trigonometry, Math III, or an equivalent;
- 2) Advanced science: Chemistry, Physics, Biology II, or an equivalent;
- 3) AP courses in core subjects;
- 4) International baccalaureate courses in core subjects;
- 5) Courses taken at a unit of the University System of Georgia in core subjects where such courses are not remedial and developmental courses; or
- 6) Advanced foreign language courses taken at an eligible high school, ex. Spanish II, etc.

****Any higher course taken at an eligible high school or taken for degree level credit at an eligible postsecondary institution is acceptable.***

MINIMUM NUMBER OF COURSES REQUIRED PRIOR TO GRADUATION: 4
