Attention Parents & Students

I am often asked why students have to pay junior dues. I am hoping that the explanation that has been provided below will help you understand why paying junior dues are important.

As part of the full high school experience, juniors and seniors have opportunities to participate in class events such as proms and picnics. In addition, seniors are also eligible to receive a host of items that commemorate their upcoming graduation from high school. The prom is hosted each year by the junior class, and seniors are special guests of the junior class. In order to ensure these memorable moments occur, junior and senior dues must be collected. The amount of dues is based on: 1) average student enrollment of each class; and 2) projected costs associated with hosting these events. Dues must be paid in advance by the established due date so that the venue and related materials for prom can be secured. Payment in advance is also needed to purchase items associated with other junior activities (ex. end of the year activity). Please note that all junior and/or senior dues, once paid, are non-refundable.

As stated earlier seniors are guest of the junior class, therefore seniors who met their financial obligations during their junior year will be permitted to attend prom at no cost (date tickets not included).
